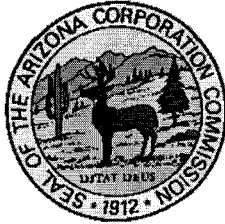

- APS is using flawed data and logic to justify their proposal; APS sells the DG energy to other Customers at their retail rates, including additional surcharges, and are fully compensated for all costs and the full amount credited to the NM Customer;
- The REST contemplated the cost, polls have indicated that Voters/Ratepayers overwhelmingly support DG
- Local DG generation avoids more system expenses than it's retail costs, which include transmission infrastructure, transmission energy loss, incremental generation to replace energy lost during transmission resulting in greater emissions and ECA charges, is coincident with peak power and reduces demand & TOU, no PPFAC

\_APS is ostensibly proposing this "expedited" action out of fairness to Residential Customers that do not generate solar electricity....if "heard" the ACC would likely set a precedent for other Customer "fairness" issues, to be heard which would likely include requests to adjust the few Customer Mine Special Contract rates to equal those paid by the many Residential Customers

-Although the ACC eliminated Commercial Scale DG PBI's APS/TEP continue to receive subsidies for their solar facilities; patently unfair, and not appropriate, especially for shareholder owned facilities; consider eliminating them.

APS is competent, they can earn the funds they are requesting via prudent cost reduction actions.
