

APPLICATION OF THE ALLIANCE FOR SOLAR CHOICE
FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to A.A.C. Rule 14-3-105, The Alliance for Solar Choice ("TASC") hereby applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order granting it leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. Concurrent with this application, TASC is filing a protest in this proceeding.

Rule 14-3-105 provides that "persons, other than the original parties to the proceedings, who are directly and substantially affected by the proceedings, shall secure an order from the Commission or presiding officer granting leave to intervene before being allowed to participate." TASC advocates for maintaining successful distributed solar energy policies, such as retail net metering ("NEM"), throughout the United States. Founding members represent the majority of the nation's rooftop solar market and include SolarCity, Sungevity, Sunrun and Verengo. These companies are important stakeholders in Arizona's Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") and NEM programs and are responsible for thousands of residential, school, church, government and

commercial solar installations in the State. Together, these companies have brought hundreds of jobs and many tens of millions of dollars of investment to Arizona's cities and towns.

The proposals put forth by APS in the Application filed in this proceeding would undoubtedly kill the solar industry in Arizona and be detrimental to the livelihoods of the approximately 10,000 individuals employed by the solar industry. As such, TASC's members will be directly and substantially affected by APS's application. Only through direct participation in this proceeding can TASC's interests be protected. Accordingly, TASC's application to intervene should be granted. Granting TASC intervenor status will not unduly broaden the issues nor unreasonably delay the proceeding, except upon leave of the Commission first had and received.
