PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 9, 2002, Metrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix"),<sup>1</sup> and International Exchange Communications, Inc. ("International") (collectively "Applicants") filed a joint application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of the transfer of certain assets and related transactions and a waiver of applicable anti-slamming regulations in the State of Arizona ("Application").

On September 17, 2003, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests.

On October 7, 2003, Applicants filed a response to Staff's Letter and Data Requests.

On August 25, 2004, Applicants filed a letter stating that the transfer of certain assets of International to Matrix had taken place, that public notice of the Application had been provided to affected subscribers, and that Matrix adopted the tariff of International.

On July 7, 2007, Staff mailed a Second Set of Data Requests to Applicants.

On July 16, 2007, Staff mailed a Second Set of Data Requests to Applicants at a separate address.

From July 16, 2007 to present no additional filings have been made in this docket.




