On July 12, 2013, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed an application for approval of its Net Metering Cost Shift Solution (the "Application") with the Arizona Corporation Commission (the "ACC") in Docket No. E-01345A-13-0248 (the "Docket"). Solar Energy Industries Association ("SEIA"), by and through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to

1 R14-3-105, hereby respectfully requests that the ACC issue an Order granting it leave to
2 intervene in the Docket. In support of this Motion, SEIA states the following:

9 and the business of its members and their respective customers in Arizona; and

10 4) Granting SEIA intervenor status will not delay this proceeding, unduly
11 broaden the issues or prejudice APS, and no other party can adequately represent SEIA's
12 interests in this matter.


