Dear Commissioners,

I am writing as a customer of APS who invested a lot of our retirement savings to install a solar system on our house. The rules said that all power generated by our solar system must be added to the power grid. It will take years before we see a complete payoff of that investment for our solar system. In the meantime, APS (a monopoly) is using our solar system's generated power.

The reason we chose to install a solar system was because the only time I ever believed words from the mouth of the current occupant of the White House was when he said that under his regime, electricity costs would "necessarily skyrocket." As a senior citizen, I knew we needed to take steps that would help us to survive financially in our waning years on this earth. It turned out to be a wise move, or so we thought, because costs for everything are "skyrocketing", and our household income remains fixed. My husband has many health issues which increasingly drain our fixed monthly income.

APS has recently tacked onto our bill an "Account Service Charge" because apparently our generating electricity for APS is seen as a financial deficit by APS. The highly esteemed economist Thomas Sowell has written:

"A very versatile term in political vocabulary is 'fairness.' Some want a definition of what today is deemed "fair." But a concrete definition would destroy the versatility of the word, which is what makes it so useful politically. Life in general has never been even close to fair, so the pretense that a government can make it fair is an inexhaustible asset to politicians who want more government."

As a senior citizen on a fixed income-whose annual earnings during my final working years prior to our retiring from Massachusetts to Arizona reached its peak far below \$45,000, and whose husband's health issues prevented his ability to earn half that much as a truck driver-the word "rich" cannot be applied to this household, especially now that we are in our 70s dealing with serious health issues.

If APS gets its way to raise our electric rates, not only will we be paying higher rates out of our current retirement income, but we'll have essentially wasted our investment for the solar system. How is that FAIR?

I resent APS efforts through ads and various media to convince non-solar customers of APS that solar customers are somehow being subsidized by them. This is a divisive tactic utilized to destroy this country by the person in the White House, and he's certainly accomplished his goal in that regard. APS seems to want to pit people against each other here in Arizona. I view the tactic by ALL who utilize it as the lowest form of coercion and indoctrination. JUST STOP IT!
