PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Vacates Hearing)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 15, 2013, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against TV Products, LLC ("TVP") and Stephen Christopher Donovan (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of membership interests in TVP.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On February 19, 2013, Respondents filed an Answer to the Notice in this matter, and their Answer will be treated as their request for a hearing pursuant to A.R.S §44-1972 and A.A.C. R14-4-306.

On February 28, 2013, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on March 14, 2013.

On March 14, 2013, at the pre-hearing conference, Respondents and the Division appeared through counsel. Counsel for Respondents and the Division's attorney indicated that a hearing should be scheduled after August 1st to last for at least two days.

On March 18, 2013, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled on August 6, 2013.

1 On April 23, 2013, due to a scheduling conflict, the proceeding was continued to August 14,
2 2013.

3 On June 21, 2013, the Division filed a Motion to Allow telephonic testimony. There were no
4 objections to this motion.

5 On July 2, 2013, by Procedural Order, the Division's Motion to Allow telephonic testimony
6 was granted.

7 On August 9, 2013, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate Hearing Dates. The Division states
8 that Respondents have no objection to the Motion, and that a proposed form of Consent Order will be
9 submitted to the Commission for its approval.

10 Accordingly, the hearing scheduled to begin on August 14, 2013 should be vacated.

11 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the **hearing scheduled on August 14, 2013, is hereby**
12 **vacated.**

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
14 Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this
15 matter is final and non-appealable.


16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
17 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
18 *pro hac vice*.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
20 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
21 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
22 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
23 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
24 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
2 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
3 ruling at hearing.
