PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Granting Interventions and Admission
Pro Hac Vice)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 12, 2013, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of Net Metering Cost Shift Solution.

Numerous public comments have been filed.

Intervention has been granted to Lewis M. Levenson, Arizona Solar Deployment Alliance, Arizona Competitive Power Alliance, Patty Ihle, Tucson Electric Power, UNS Electric, Inc., and the Residential Utility Consumer Office.

On August 12, 2013, Solar Energy Industries Association ("SEIA") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene.

No objection to SEIA's intervention has been filed. Accordingly, SEIA should be granted intervention.

On August 12, 2013, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Court S. Rich, an Arizona-licensed attorney, filed with the Commission a Motion for Todd G. Glass to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* in the above-captioned matter, on behalf of SEIA ("Motion").

The Motion lists Mr. Rich as the designated member of the Arizona State Bar with whom communications may be made and upon whom papers should be served. Attached to the Motion is a Verified Application to Appear *Pro Hac Vice*; a copy of Mr. Glass's certificates of good standing

1 from the jurisdictions in which he has been admitted to practice law; and a copy of a check made
2 payable to the State Bar of Arizona.

3 In the Discretion of the Commission, Todd G. Glass should be permitted to appear and
4 participate in the above-captioned matter on behalf of SEIA.

5 On August 15, 2013, a Notice of Appearance of Counsel was filed on behalf of The Alliance
6 for Solar Choice ("TASC"), which has an intervention request pending. The Notice states that
7 TASC's member companies include Sunrun, SolarCity, Verengo, Clean Power Finance and
8 Sungevity.

9 No objection to TASC's intervention request has been filed. Accordingly, TASC should be
10 granted intervention.

11 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that The Alliance for Solar Choice is hereby granted
12 intervention in this matter.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Solar Energy Industries Association is hereby granted
14 intervention in this matter.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Todd G. Glass is hereby admitted *pro hac vice* to
16 participate in the above-captioned matter on behalf of Solar Energy Industries Association.

with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona

1 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at
2 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
3 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
4 Administrative Law Judge.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
