PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 31, 2013, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision Nos. 73636 for Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”), 73637 for Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP”), and 73638 for UNS Electric, Inc. (“UNS”) in the above-captioned dockets (“2013 REST dockets”).¹ Those Decisions directed that the Commission would consider the proposed

1 "Track and Record" mechanism (as well as alternatives thereto), for APS, TEP and UNS at a hearing.

2 The parties to this proceeding are APS, TEP, UNS, the Commission's Utilities Division
3 ("Staff"), Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold, Inc. ("Freeport-McMoRan"), Arizonans for Electric
4 Choice and Competition ("AECC"), Solar Energy Industries Association ("SEIA"), Western
5 Resource Advocates ("WRA"), the Vote Solar Initiative ("Vote Solar"), Arizona Solar Energy
6 Industries Association ("AriSEIA"), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC ("NextEra"), Wal-Mart Stores,
7 Inc. and Sam's West Inc. (collectively "Walmart"), the United States Department of Defense and all
8 other Federal Executive Agencies ("DoD/FEA"), Interwest Energy Alliance ("Interwest"), Kevin
9 Koch, NRG Solar ("NRG"), and the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO").

10 A hearing on Track and Record issues was held, and concluded on June 21, 2013. The parties
11 agreed to a briefing schedule and were directed to file simultaneous initial closing briefs on August
12 23, 2013, by 4:00 p.m. and reply closing briefs on September 10, 2013, by 4:00 p.m.

13 On August 22, 2013, DoD/FEA filed its initial closing brief.

14 Also on August 22, 2013, Staff filed a Request for a 2 Day Extension of Time to File Initial
15 Briefs ("Request"). The Request states that the extension of time is necessary for Staff due to
16 conflicts with other matters that have arisen. Counsel for Staff states that it emailed other parties
17 concerning the Request, and no party had objected. Staff states specifically that it does not request
18 any change to the deadline for reply briefs.

19 Under the circumstances, Staff's request will be granted.

20 Any party who wishes a corresponding extension of time to file reply briefs may file a request
21 to that effect.

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1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the deadline for filing initial closing briefs in this matter
2 is hereby extended to Tuesday, August 27, 2013, at 4:00 p.m.
