PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 3, 2013, Holiday Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Holiday Water Company ("Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a permanent rate increase under Docket No. W-01896A-13-0238 ("Rate Application"). Also on July 3, 2013, the Company filed an application for authority to incur long-term debt under Docket No. W-01896A-13-0239 ("Finance Application").

The Company included in each Application a copy of the notice sent to customers advising them of the filing, with affidavits averring the notices were mailed to customers on July 3, 2013.

The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") docketed a Letter of Sufficiency in the Rate Application docket on July 31, 2013, advising the Company that its Rate Application met the sufficiency requirements of Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-103, and that the Staff Report regarding the Rate Application would be docketed on approximately October 14, 2013.

Pursuant to Procedural Orders filed in each docket on August 13, 2013, concurrent procedural conferences were held on August 22, 2013, to discuss whether the two dockets should be consolidated.

During the procedural conferences, Staff asserted the matters are substantially related and should be consolidated and the Company agreed. Staff stated it did not believe it would need more time to complete the Staff Report for the consolidated matters than that stated in the Rate

1 Application's Sufficiency Letter. The October 14, 2013, filing date for the Staff Report falls on a
2 State holiday and the date should be extended to October 15, 2013.

3 Because the matters are substantially related and no party will be prejudiced by consolidation,
4 it is reasonable to consolidate to Rate Application and Finance Application dockets.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Docket Nos. W-01896A-13-0238 and W-01896A-13-**
6 **0239 are hereby consolidated.**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing the **Staff Report** is changed from
8 October 14, 2013, to **October 15, 2013.**

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *Ex Parte* Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
10 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
11 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38, Rules of the
13 Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 regarding practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
15 waive any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


