**TUCSON ELECTRIC POWER
COMPANY'S MOTION TO
EXTEND CERTAIN
COMPLIANCE DATES**

Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP"), through undersigned counsel, hereby requests to extend the compliance date from August 30, 2013 to October 30, 2013 for the following compliance filings required by Decision No. 73912 (June 27, 2013):

1. A proposed Partial Requirements Service Tariff;
2. A proposed Super-Peak Time-of-Use Tariff; and
3. A proposed Interruptible Tariff.

TEP needs additional time to prepare the compliance filings because the personnel responsible for developing the tariffs are also involved in the pending UNS Electric rate case (Docket No. E-04204A-12-0504). Since mid-July, those personnel have been heavily involved in the settlement negotiations in that docket. Although the parties to the UNS Electric rate case have reached a settlement in principle, they are now engaged in finalizing the settlement agreement and numerous related attachments thereto. The UNS Electric settlement agreement is due on September 6, 2013 and a hearing on the settlement is scheduled to start on September 30, 2013. As a result, the key personnel for developing the TEP compliance filings will be unable to complete the required tariffs by August 30, 2013.

Moreover, TEP intends to utilize the additional time to work with interested parties in an effort to gain consensus on the form of each tariff.

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
