ISSUES IN COMPLAINT TO THE CITIZENS'  
JURISDICTION"

Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("MEC") hereby responds and objects to Complainants' "Motion to Transfer Issues in Complaint to the Citizens' Jurisdiction." There is no "public citizens' jurisdiction" or public citizens' court. This Motion is frivolous and without any merit. There is no basis for "transferring issues" unique to the jurisdiction of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") to any other court, let alone to a non-existent court. All of the issues alleged in the Complainants' formal Complaint can only be brought before the ACC. The Complainants have been using the ACC and the Arizona judicial system as forums to engage in vexatious conduct against MEC. The Motion should be denied and MEC so urges. It is appropriate for the Commission to exercise what equitable jurisdiction it has for instructing the Complainants to cease the filing of frivolous pleadings and the vexatious documents in this docket.
