I worked in the power industry for 16 years. I left for the water industry at the beginning of deregulation in 1996. I now broker energy in 14 states, Canada, Australia, and Europe. What I have learned about the deregulation of energy:

- It should be in place to help the residential and small business customers. Enron et al made it about the big business owners. Big business uses a large amount of energy and they negotiate a rate with the utility (their own version of deregulation).
- Electric and gas utilities with need to learn about efficiency. When I started in the power industry in 1980, a job with a utility was "for life". To fire a non-productive employee took an act of Congress.
- You will have your hands full regulating some of the utilities. Investor-owned utilities are used to getting the maximum rate of return. I see them nickel and diming their delivery rates.
- I have viewed the tariffs of regulated utilities in states that are already deregulated. There is a large variance from state to state. The commissions in these states have addressed the tasks that you will be doing shortly. Arizona has a starting point and doesn't have to begin from scratch. Hopefully, we take the parts from each that are best for Arizona.
- How many new power plants were built in Arizona in the anticipation of deregulation? We have already started.
- I hope the current commission will have deregulation in place before the next election. We need various methods of electrical generation so that so that diversity prevents our reliance on just one form. I am concerned that this state will be covered not only in solar cells, but in inefficient ways. (I studied solar electrical generation at ASU hoping it was the industry of the future; what I see on some houses is a waste of money).

This Commission has the opportunity to move this state forward than any Commission in the past. Let's make it happen!
