RE: APS Cherry Picking Law: Did the ACC Pass One?

APS is acting as if they have the right to Cherry Pick among customers. Did the ACC pass a clandestine Decision or Order that allows APS to cheery pick and discriminate, according to its whim, in direct contradiction to the customer freedom of choice as expressed in the July 30, 2007 in Docket E-00000A-06-0038 DECISION NO. 69736 ORDER that allows for freedom of choice, "upon customer request" to chose a so called 'smart' / automated /AMI meter or not?

In addition, we are all reminded that A.R.S. 40-361.B provides: "Every public service corporation shall furnish and maintain such service, equipment and facilities as will promote the safety, health, comfort and convenience of its patrons, employees and the public, and as will be in all respects adequate, efficient and reasonable." There has been no environmental impact study on AMI technology proving long term safety for exposed humans, animals or plants. In this department the EPA has been conveniently downsized into practical nonexistence. Without the definitive proof that NEPA EPA studies could provide and in the face of volumes of documents submitted by the public in Docket E-00000C-11-0328, APS and the ACC are currently without much of a 'fig leaf' to protect the APS assumption that it is not harming the public with AMI technology. May we remind the Arizona Corporation Commission is required to secure public safety under **A.R.S. 40-321.A** which states: "When the commission finds that the equipment, appliances, facilities or service of any public service corporation, or the methods of manufacture, distribution, transmission, storage or supply employed by it, are unjust, unreasonable, unsafe, improper, inadequate or insufficient, the commission shall determine what is just, reasonable, safe, proper, adequate or sufficient, and shall enforce its determination by order or regulation."

In the case of Patricia Ferre, who has repeatedly requested a safe analog meter for her home since June 15, 2012, for her "safety, health, comfort and convenience", APS has deceived her and misrepresented the electrical meters installed on her home. Thus far APS has refused to install a safe analog meter on the home of Patricia Ferre.
