Pursuant to Section 12.3 of the Settlement Agreement approved by Decision No. 73912 (June 27, 2013) (“Decision”), Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP”) is required to:

“In compliance with Decision No. 59594 (March 29, 1996), TEP set up a LIFE Fund of \$4.5 million. The annual interest from the LIFE Fund was used the benefit of low-income customers. The Signatories agree that the LIFE Fund should be extinguished and that TEP will make an annual contribution to the Arizona Community Action Association in the amount of \$150,000 to fund low-income utility bill assistance programs, commencing on September 1, 2013.”
