**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE FILING  
SUBMITTING ANNUAL PREPAID  
SERVICE DATA**

Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("MEC"), through its undersigned attorneys, submits its compliance filing regarding its annual prepaid service data. Decision No. 73352 requires MEC to annually file each September certain data related to its prepaid service for the prior 12 months. In particular, the decision provides:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated shall annually file beginning September 2013 for the prior 12-month period with Docket Control, as a compliance item in this docket, the following information: the number of prepaid metering customers per month; the number of disconnects per account per month, specifying the number of low-income customers (if the Company has the ability to track low-income data); the number of prepaid metering customers that have been disconnected for 24 hours or more (in 24-hour increments) and the number of accounts with repeated disconnections per month; and the number of customer complaints specific to prepaid metering, including a description of the types of complaints received.

1 Exhibit A attached hereto sets forth the information required to be filed related  
2 to MEC's prepaid meter service for the period September 2012 through August 2013,  
3 however, MEC did not initiate prepaid service until January of 2013. MEC does not know  
4 which of its customers are 'low income' and has no meaningful way of identifying and  
5 tracking its prepaid customers that meet specific income levels. Therefore, the data submitted  
6 does not separately set forth figures relating low income customers.


