

**IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF UNITE PRIVATE NETWORKS, LLC FOR APPROVAL OF A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES-BASED PRIVATE LINE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES IN ARIZONA. DOCKET NO. T-20534-07-0346**

On June 1, 2007, Unite Private Networks, LLC ("UPN" or the "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide facilities-based private-line telecommunication services in Arizona. UPN's application also requests a determination that its proposed services are competitive in

Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended approval of UPN's application, subject to certain conditions. The Commission will issue a Decision following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by UPN, Staff, or intervenors. If the Company's application is approved, UPN will be required to provide service under the rates, charges, terms and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of UPN's application, the Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report, filed by the Company will be available at UPN's offices 950 West 92 Highway, Suite 203, Kearney, MO 64060; at the Commission's Docket Control Center at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona; and on the internet via the Commission's website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-Docket function. The Commission will hold a hearing on UPN's application on October 15, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-20534-07-0346 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to Intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to UPN or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address and telephone number, and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor;
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R 14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before September 25, 2013. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. All parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38 and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
