

Notice to Parties in Docket Nos. E-01345A-11-0224 and E-01345A-13-0248

On September 30, 2013, Staff docketed a Memorandum and Proposed Order in Docket No. E-01345A-13-248 (*APS's Application for Approval of Net Metering Cost Shift Solution*) (hereinafter "Net Metering Case"). In its proposal, Staff recommends that the issues raised in the Net Metering Case should be addressed in APS's next rate case. However, Staff's filing also discusses two alternatives in case the Commission elects to address these issues before APS's next rate case. The two alternatives are revenue neutral rate options that involve changes to the Lost Fixed Cost Recovery ("LFCR") mechanism adopted in APS's last rate case.

Even though Staff is recommending that the Commission defer these issues to APS's next rate case, it is possible that the Commission may approve one of the two alternative options, or some form thereof. While Staff believes that the Settlement Agreement in the last APS rate case anticipates that the Commission will make modifications to the LFCR as the Commission deems necessary, Staff is nonetheless providing notice that adoption of either of the two revenue neutral rate options discussed in Staff's filing would result in changes to the LFCR mechanism.
