Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC ("Noble Solutions") hereby joins in the October 15, 2013 Application for Rehearing filed on behalf of Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold, Inc. ("Freeport-McMoRan") and Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") in the above-captioned and above-docketed proceeding ("Instant Proceeding").¹ As a part of its Joinder, Noble Solutions hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the factual background and legal arguments set forth in the aforesaid Application for Rehearing.

Noble Solutions was an active participant as a member of the Retail Competition Advocates in the Instant Proceeding, including the submission of written Comments on July 15, 2013 and written Reply Comments on August 16, 2013. In addition, Noble Solutions as successor in interest to Sempra Energy Solutions LLC has an Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive retail electric services



2 03964A-06-0168. Thus, like Freeport-McMoRan and AECC, Noble Solutions has been
3 directly and substantially affected by the Commission's September 11, 2013 oral decision
4 to terminate further activity in the Instant Proceeding.² Accordingly, Noble Solutions
5 believes that the alternative forms of relief set forth in Freeport-McMoRan's and AECC's
6 aforesaid Application for Rehearing are most appropriate in the present circumstances.
