Dear Commissioner Stump.

Having twice written the Commission, March 11 and June 10, without courtesy of reply or even acknowledgement of receipt, I am writing you individually. Under the (I hope, correct) assumption that former Congressman Bob Stump was your dad, he was one of the three or four politicians whom I ever completely trusted. I wrote him many times, always received a rational logical reply. I'm expecting that his dedication has rubbed off on you. The above letters with enclosures, were about two separate issues. 1) Unfair APS electricity charges against "regular" users which are used to favor and enrich solar customers; and (2) Unfair proposed charges to customer wishing to opt-out of Smart Meter installation.

Gentlemen:

Let's see if I have this straight.

We pay Arizona Public Service for the use of "regular" electricity. APS then urges customers, for "green" reasons of course, to transform to solar electricity. This is a costly process. But not to worry! Because you, our AZ Corporation Commission, permit and encourage APS to offer rebates, subsidies and recycling benefits, using, of course, money from "regular" electricity users. Subsidized installation of solar systems (though still beyond the reach of many "regular" electricity users) then creates APS non-customers (see attached APS notice). Right so far?

Now APS informs the remaining "regular" electricity customers, who involuntarily have reduced the number of APS customers, that they must increase their payments to meet less- funded APS fixed costs due to fewer customers. And, incidentally, to meet the need of providing even more rebates, subsidies and recycling benefits. This, in turn, again reduces APS customers, and causes additional higher payments by the "regular" electricity suckers to meet those less- funded APS fixed costs. And around and around we go.

But, as Historian Marshall Trimble elates, the pain of high payments has been eliminated for the solar folks. How nice for them! And all this to "eliminate" a non-existent and fraudulent concept-- man-caused global warming. Shame on you and APS.
