PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Setting Procedural Conference)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 28, 2013, David Sisneros ("Complainant") filed a formal complaint with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") against Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP"). TEP filed its Answer to Formal Complaint and Motion to Dismiss on September 24, 2013.

In a Procedural Order docketed October 1, 2013, TEP's Motion to Dismiss was denied and a hearing was set for November 20, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's Tucson office.

The hearing convened as scheduled and TEP was present and represented by counsel. After postponing the proceeding for 15 minutes, the Complainant did not appear and the hearing was cancelled. TEP was advised that a Procedural Order would be issued setting a procedural conference to determine whether the Complainant desires to proceed with his Complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **telephonic procedural conference shall commence on December 16, 2013, at 11:00 a.m., call-in number: (888) 450-5996, participant no. 457395#.**

The parties may also attend in person at the Commission's Tucson offices, Room 222, 400 West Congress Street, Tucson, Arizona 85701.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **the purpose of the telephonic procedural conference will be to discuss whether the Complainant wishes to pursue his Complaint and, if so, to discuss scheduling. No other matters shall be considered during this procedural conference.**

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the Complainant no longer wishes to pursue his
2 Complaint, **he may file a Motion to Withdraw Complaint no later than December 9, 2013, as an**
3 **alternative to attending the telephonic procedural conference.**

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED advising the Complainant that if he fails to comply with the
5 above Ordering Paragraphs, or with any subsequent Orders of the Commission, **such failure may**
6 **ultimately result in administrative closure of this docket.**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *Ex Parte* Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
8 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is set for public hearing.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
10 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
11 *hac vice*.


