**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Setting Procedural Conference)**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 24, 2009, Roger and Darlene Chantel ("Complainants") filed a formal complaint ("Complaint") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") against Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("MEC" or "Company"). MEC filed its Response to Formal Complaint and Motion to Dismiss on April 10, 2009.

On November 25, 2013, a Procedural Order was docketed setting a telephonic procedural conference for December 16, 2013. The Procedural Order advised the parties that the sole purpose of the telephonic procedural conference is to discuss whether the Complainants wish to pursue their Complaint and, if so, to discuss scheduling.

On November 27, 2013, the Complainants filed a Request for Information on December 16, 2013, Conference/Hearing and a Request to Issue the Enforcement Order. In this Request, the Complainants ask Commission to provide a copy the rules to be used during the December 16, 2013, procedural conference.

10 Any issues regarding the Complainants' proposed enforcement order and other substantive  
11 issues will be addressed at the appropriate time.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **telephonic procedural conference scheduled to be**  
13 **held on December 16, 2013, at 9:00 a.m., is confirmed: CALL-IN NUMBER: (888) 450-5996,**  
14 **PARTICIPANT NO. 457395#.** The parties may also attend in person at the Commission's Tucson  
15 offices, Room 222, 400 West Congress Street, Tucson, Arizona 85701.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **the purpose of the telephonic procedural conference**  
17 **will be to discuss whether the Complainants wish to pursue their Complaint and, if so, to**  
18 **discuss scheduling. No other matters will be discussed during this procedural conference.**

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the Complainants no longer wish to pursue their  
20 Complaint before the Commission, **the Complainants may file a Motion to Withdraw Complaint**  
21 **no later than December 9, 2013, as an alternative to attending the telephonic procedural**  
22 **conference.**


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED advising the Complainants that their failure to appear at the  
24 telephonic procedural conference or comply with the above Ordering Paragraphs, or with any  
25 subsequent Orders of the Commission, **MAY ULTIMATELY RESULT IN ADMINISTRATIVE**  
26 **CLOSURE OF THIS DOCKET.**

27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Commission Staff is not required to attend this telephonic  
28 procedural conference.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
2 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
3 *hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,  
5 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by  
6 ruling at hearing.
