In the letter of Commissioner Robert Burns dated December 6, 2013, stakeholders were asked, along with their related organizations, to answer the following three questions by December 20, 2013.

The Arizona Independent Scheduling Administrator Association (AZISA) participated in this Docket and has the following answers.

(1) How much money did your company, organization, shareholders and/or parent company spend to support your positions on retail electric competition? Your answers should include funds spent to support lobbying efforts and contributions to organizations that lobby or retain lobbyists to promote views that you support. Your answers should also include general service contractors who were retained in any capacity but perhaps were not required to register as lobbyists by virtue of a contractual agreement.

The AZISA spent no money on lobbyists or contractors to represent its interests in this Docket. The salaried Executive Director wrote the Initial and Reply Comments, after review and approval of the Board, as part of the daily job responsibilities. Minor outside legal costs were incurred to review a few aspects of the pleadings.

(2) Please identify the approximate number of hours your salaried staff spent on the public relations campaign to support your positions.

No hours were spent on public relations campaigns. The Executive Director did make a short presentation during the RUCO workshop based on the filed comments.

(3) If you are a regulated utility, will you be requesting compensation in a future rate case for funds expended to promote your views?

No, this is not applicable to the AZISA. The AZISA is a FERC regulated entity and its funding is part of a FERC regulated tariff.
