PUBLIC NOTICE OF AIC's PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE FUEL ADJUSTOR RATE

DOCKET NO. E-1025A-13-0352

On October 15, 2013 Ajo Improvement Company ("AIC") proposed to increase its purchase power and fuel adjustor clause ("PPFAC") rate from \$0.01 per kWh to \$0.0325 per kWh. Based on average residential use of approximately 525 kWh, the residential customer's bill would reflect an increase of approximately \$11.83 per month (starting in February, 2014) if the Commission approves increasing the PPFAC rate to \$0.0325 per kWh versus having the PPFAC rate remain at \$0.01 per kWh. AIC's Application is available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission's offices at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the eDocket function - or can be made available upon request at AIC's offices at South Highway 85, Ajo, Arizona 85321. For more information, please call (520) 387-2001.

You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R-14-3-105. If you wish to intervene you must file an original and 13 copies of a timely written motion to intervene with the Commission and send a copy of the motion to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record. The motion must, at a minimum, contain the following: (1) Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made; if different from the intervenor; (2) a short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer or potential customer of the Applicant, etc.); (3) a statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Applicant or their counsel and to all parties of record in the case. If representation by counsel is required by Rule 31 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to request a hearing. If a hearing is ordered, an intervenor is permitted to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene, however, will not preclude any interested person or entity from providing public comment on the application. The Commission anticipates considering this matter at a future Open Meeting. Public comment regarding the application will be taken at that time.
