Dateland Public Service Company Inc. (DPSC)

Explanations for pages 3 & 4

Changes in current, compared to past operations, that necessitate the rate adjustment.

Item 1

1) Dateland Public Service Co. Inc. (DPSC) was awarded a USDA grant and the project will be completed by 2014. Our treatment facility has been updated with a Everfilt pretreatment system, a new Doosan Reverse Osmosis system, two new wells, two additional reject water ponds, an additional 100,000 treated water tank, a 74kw solar power system, 50kw generator and a programmable computer that runs all systems. Unfortunately the new operation requires a maintenance staff which has not been a requirement for DPSC in the past.

The equipment must be monitored on a daily basis. When the system fails it calls our water operator and operation's manager. When these occur the system must be trouble shot and all systems must be checked to verify that they are once again working correctly. Our water operator (Donald Lane) is on call since he is the only person, in Dateland, that can trouble shoot, re-set, and maintain our new system.

Donald Lane has agreed to maintain the DPSC equipment. Since DPSC does not have employees this cost needs to be added into our annual budget. Since Donald is a level 2 operator he is well qualified to maintain and oversee our system. For 2013, he has agreed to be reimbursed \$1,000 per month for his time. This rate is well under the standard for a level 2 water system operator. Although DPSC is happy to have Donald, they must build in a workable salary for a full time operator. If Donald retires, or leaves the community, the salary for a level 2 operator would be \$45,000 per year. This amount of money would allow DPSC to maintain an operator and allow for the standard maintenance that must be performed on a quarterly, semi- annual, and annual basic. DPSC must increase the current rates charged in order to meet this need. This is not an unreasonable request, this salary would allow DPSC to maintain the equipment that we use in our treatment facility. IF DPSC could pay for a full time operator, part of the salary would be used to maintain and trouble shoot. It is our desire to have this be part of an on-going budget. This would be an increase of \$33,000.00 annually for a level 2 operator at the current employment rates. DPSC is proposing that we pay an operator \$36,000 annually. Although this is a reduced rate from the current market standards, our treatment system is small and this rate would be comparable because rents are less in the Dateland community.

We have reduced our purchased power costs by the installation of the solar power system. Having the solar power system has reduced our electrical costs from \$1,000.00 per month to approximately \$400.00 per month. This will save DPSC \$ 7,200.00 annually. Part of this savings will be used to purchase fuel, oil, etc. to maintain our new 50kw generator. An annual maintenance agreement for our generator will run approximately \$3,000.00. Once our rate increase has been approved we believe that we will have the financial ability to pay for this much needed service. DPSC needs to maintain our generator since we experience many power failures in our remote area, and the generator is our only means to back up power. Because of the solar DPSC saves \$ 2,000.00 annually after all generator

costs are calculated. We are estimating annual costs of \$1,700 as replacement costs and \$3,000 in annual maintenance.

Our new system requires salt be added to the pre-treatment tank, and anti-scalant to be added to the new RO. These additional costs must be added into our annual budget. We purchase salt every quarter and the cost runs around \$4,200 annually. We purchase anti-scalant every 6 months and it costs \$3,000 annually. These are costs that are either new or greatly increased. Our current budget only allowed for anti-scalant and this cost ran \$1,200.00 annually. This in an increase of \$6,000.00 annually. We are estimating an annual cost of \$ 7,200.00 for salt and anti-scalant.

DPSC now has a work truck that was purchased for \$2,639.57. This truck requires fuel, insurance and maintenance which have been added into the 2013 budget. DPSC's cost for tires, insurance, fuel, and maintenance runs \$3,000 annually. This must be added into our annual budget. We estimate that \$3,000 would allow us to make the needed repairs to both our truck and trencher. We are proposing the purchase of a newer truck. This expense would be paid for by fixing and selling the RO system that we removed from service.

Our solar panels require cleaning and monitoring, this will became part of the maintenance/water operator's duties. DPSC is estimating solar panel replacements cost to be around \$750.00 annually. We are estimating replacement cost of the 264 panels and the 64kw invertors to run \$13,000 in additional money for a total annual cost of \$13,750.00

DPSC now has three reject water ponds instead of just one. These ponds must be maintained, kept clean and monitored, so as not to become a contamination issue. Dateland experiences extreme winds and often trash is found in our ponds due to the winds. The trash must be removed. DPSC is located in a remote area and it is our desire that our reject water should be available to migrating birds as well as wildlife. We need to be maintaining our ponds to create a safe drinking water source for the migrating birds. This has been underway for 3 years and has been a success. We estimate that the cost to clean the ponds can be added into the cost of an operator, but when the ponds have to be drained and cleaned the cost of removing the soil and the environmental dump fees will run around \$10,000. Although our last pond was cleaned in 2013, we estimate that every 5 years, each pond would require soil removal and environmental dump fees. DPSC needs to add this cost to our annual budget, and budgeting \$6,000.00 annually would meet our needs.

DPSC hired Michelle Lane to be our operation's manager, as an outside service. While the plant was under construction the bulk of her wages were paid by the USDA. Now that the USDA costs are exhausted in this account, DPSC will once again be responsible to cover these costs. Michelle has agreed to be reimbursed \$12,000 annually and works part-time. The going market rate for her services would be (\$11.00) per customer or \$1,265.00 per month, which equals \$15,180.00 annually. DPSC needs to increase it's budget by \$3,180.00 to meet current market rates. Michelle also provides annual tax filings, monthly and quarterly reporting, etc. and DPSC estimates that if these were paid annually to a CPA firm the cost would be \$5,000.00 annually. DPSC that we need to increase this amount by

\$8,180.00 annually to meet the State, Federal, etc. reporting costs. This account needs to have an annual budget of \$14,400 to provide accounting, billing, receivable, etc.

DPSC was a very small water system that was located on one acre before the USDA grant upgrades. DPSC is now located on four acres and requires lots of maintenance. Part of our award with the USDA is the requirement that we maintain our systems. It is DPSC's intention to maintain our system and continue to provide "safe" quality drinking water to our customers. We feel that it is our responsibility to keep and maintain the system that has been provided to us by USDA.

Enclosed I have provided a list of our budget information for account 620 and account 630 since these accounts need to be evaluated to meet our needs. Our current budget does not provide the money needed to maintain our upgraded equipment or replacement costs. DPSC would like our new rates to reflect and provide for these financial needs.

2. DPSC has retired the RO system and pre-treatment that was our existing water treatment system. We maintained our original pond and added two additional ponds. We maintained our 50,000 storage tank, (re-habed it) and added an additional 100,000 storage tank. These will show in the following documentation.

DPSC's old existing equipment might have a value for a smaller water system, but in order to market it we must make needed repairs even to sell as is. During our construction the crew dismantled our RO systems and it has been damaged. In order to sell this RO we must first return it to working condition. We removed a 10,000 well storage tank from our system and we have been trying to find a small system that we could sell or donate this tank. Once the RO is rehabed and sold we would like to use this money for the purchase of a newer work truck. Our current truck is a 1986 and DPSC would like to upgrade this truck within the next few years. No money is being added to our budget because the money obtained from the sale of the above would cover this expense.

Since this items have been removed from service they have been deducted from our assets.

Significant factors influencing your revenues, expenses and/or rate base. Item 3.

3. DPSC determines that we have several factors that influence our expenses most of the additional costs have been listed under item 1 above. DPSC estimates annual costs of \$58,288 for account 620 which would keep our facility in compliance with all existing State and Federal regulations. Account 630 would need to have an annual budget of \$57,650 to provide basic personnel (outside services) needed.

DPSC's general liability insurance has increased from \$1,800 to around \$ 3,000. This is an increase in cost due to our upgraded facility.

DPSC is estimating a loss in revenue for 2013. Our customer base has decreased over the last few years. We are located in a "slow" growth area with below average income averages. We are estimating a loss for 2013 to run around \$12,000 for our annual budget. Although DPSC has tried to file an exempt status on our property taxes it was not allowed by the State and our property taxes have increased by \$2,500 due to our new upgraded plant and the value of the 4 acre site compared to the previous 1 acre site. Our property taxes paid in 2013 was \$4,800, this in an increase of \$2,300. DPSC has made efforts to have this amount reduced but the State has not allowed this at this time, therefore our budget needs to reflect the current taxes paid.

DPSC understands that in order to properly maintain our equipment, and meet USDA demands, we must be proactive and add additional costs to our budget. Our new pumps cost an average of \$7,500 to replace and we do not currently have the funds available to replace them. We have two VFD well pumps, each costing \$7,500.00 to replace. We have two VFD distribution pumps having a replacement cost of \$7,500.00 each. These pumps should have an estimated 5 year life, and we need \$6,000.00 annually to be set aside for replacement costs.

DPSC needs to increase our rates drastically in order to meet our new equipment costs and to be competitive with our wages paid to our outside service vendors. Because of our remoteness we need to be competitive, we need people living in Dateland. Before Donald Lane became our operator, vendors would charge an average of \$1,000.00 for trip fees. When our new equipment experiences a problem it affects the entire treatment system. If the psi or gpm do not meet the requirements, these changes will prevent the distribution of water to our customers. If DPSC has to depend upon a vendor traveling from Yuma or Phoenix our customers could be without water until the pressures are fixed. DPSC needs to have a trained operator on site. DPSC must offer competitive wages in order to maintain the trained staff that is needed to operate our facility in order to meet all State and Federal regulations. Travel costs are hard to estimate because some of the vendors come from Yuma and others from Phoenix. Often a vendor would travel to the sight to determine the problem, return and order the parts, and then return days later to make the repair. DPSC now requires qualified staff on site and our budget will be more consistent and we can better meet our customer's water demands.

Item 4

4. DPSC has lost a few customers during the last few years. We have been able to maintain our customer count due to new home construction. We have been able to maintain around 115 customers through-out most of the year. Dateland has a few new businesses located to the north (Solar One, APS) but the anticipated employment numbers have not benefited the Dateland homeowners or our small community. DPSC is set-up for single family residences and we do not have businesses that access our water system. Our growth is

limited to single family residences and although we would like our community to grow, we do not anticipate this event to happen. We may increase by 2 or 3 but we expect to lose as many customers as we gain.

Anticipated construction

Item 5

We are in the process of building a maintenance/office building. We expect that this building will cost DPSC around \$10,000. USDA is funding most of the building but we can only use the money that is part of our initial grant, USDA will not fund any additional money for this project. We are expecting the building to cost \$120,000 and USDA will fund \$110,000. We have money set aside to cover the additional cost of the building because we received a rebate on our solar power system. We are budgeting in the cost of running an office and providing a maintenance building. We will furnish the office with a board room in order to hold our monthly open board meeting. We are budgeting \$6,000 annually for purchased power (615) and office expenses (621) of \$6,000 annually.

Currently DPSC does not have an office. The office has been situated in the home of Michelle Lane. Michelle currently pays for the phone, electricity and cable costs out of her monthly wages. DPSC does not feel that this is a good business practice and wants to relocate the office once the new building has been completed. By moving the office DPSC will need to budget for certain expenses.

DPSC lacks a bathroom and because of this issue we have been unable to hold meetings at our site. Once the new building has been constructed we will offer field trips to our local schools. We are currently working with the school teachers on our Board to set up these programs.

Efforts made to encourage conservation of water through the proposed rate design or through other means.

Item 6

6. We are currently working with our local schools to establish field trips where the local children will learn about water, how to treat water, and how to conserve water. We can not move forward with this goal until we have bathroom facilities. We are working with USDA and have a PER on file with them at this time.

We encourage people to conserve and most of our customers have taken advantage of water conservation. We still have broken lines, etc. and some water is lost due to line breaks, but most of our customers fix these breaks quickly because of the rates. We understand that there will always be customers that overuse, but we believe that a good rate system educates the customers and they conserve.

Our proposed rate structure will help us to educate our customers on the need to conserve

water and the field trip programs that we are working on will educate the children and they will help to educate their parents. Higher rates are a deterrent to water waste and help to educate customers to conserve.

DPSC currently utilizes some of the EPA programs to help to educate our customers regarding water conservation. We will continue to use these programs and will expand them once our new building has been constructed. Other factors

Item 7

7. Although DPSC is requesting a substantial rate increase we understand that there are certain factors that we need to address at this time. We are a non-profit corporation and we depend upon grant money to get us into compliance and to keep us in compliance. Unfortunately USDA grant funds have been drastically reduced from 50 million per year, to 2 million per year, for the State of Arizona. Because of this drastic reduction of funds we do not believe that we will receive any additional funds from the USDA. We understand that these grant funds will go to companies that are out of compliance and need the funds to get into State and Federal compliance. DPSC's responsibility is to maintain the treatment facility and our rate structure is the core of this responsibility.

If we fail to maintain our facility and have to borrow money or try to secure a USDA grant, we will only be able to have grant funds of 40% (maximum), therefore forcing us to borrow 60% or more as needed to make the repair, replace the equipment, etc. This would be a financial hardship and one that would be difficult to absorb.

DPSC is owned by it's customers and our customers have the responsibility of maintaining it's facility. We understand that no one wants to pay more for water, but we also understand that this financial burden is the responsibility of DPSC's customers/owners. We do not expect to be awarded any additional grants and because of that fact, we need to become financially stable. We do not have the luxury of providing less water or less quality water, we must maintain our compliance and we believe that this rate increase should allow us to become financially stable and maintain our good compliance with the State and Federal regulatory agencies.

It is our goal to be financially stable within 5 years. It is our goal to maintain the money needed for replacement parts as they are needed. It is our goal to maintain qualified staff that understand the needs of both the company and especially the needs of the people. Safe drinking water is a must, and that is our goal both now and in the future.

We are requesting that the ACC grant our rate increase as proposed. Although, our new proposed rates will not fulfill our needs immediately, DPSC must present an educated understanding of what is needed and why. As a business we must become financially stable and remain financially stable. Our proposed budget would allow us to become financially stable and by becoming financially stable DPSC can meet our customer's needs and fulfill the regulatory agencies requirements.

DPSC believes that there are numerous companies that are struggling to provide safe drinking water to it's customers, we have meet this requirement because of our USDA grant. It is now our responsibility to maintain the facility that has been provided to us. Maintaining our facility is our responsibility and we can meet this responsibility with the right rate increase and rate structure.

DPSC will request an updated rate increase within 2 to 3 years, and we anticipate that this proposed rate increase and a future rate increase will secure our finances.

Like most small companies financial stability is imperative to our future. DPSC understands our financial responsibility to maintain our equipment. DPSC understands that we must make a few difficult decisions at this time in order to survive and to continue to provide our customers with safe drinking water that meets regulatory requirements. It is with this in financial need mind that we request this rate increase.

Budgeting for future years

DPSC understands the need to be competitive. It is our 5 year goal to have our salaries, etc. current with the market standards, but in order to accomplish this goal we need to make a few drastic rate increases at this time. If the DPSC's customers do not make these changes at this time we/they will find ourselves in need of money in the very near future. It is our desire to be financially independent of grants and loans. We are assuming that grants are going to be too difficult to obtain and loans will impact our budget due to interest rates, terms, etc. We understan that in order to better serve our customer's needs we must look at the future and build our rates according to our current and future financial needs. Therefore this is the budget that we will need in order to meet our current needs and to secure our future.

The bulk of the increase that we are requesting is for our level 2 water operator and for future maintenance. DPSC considered maintaining our operator on a part time basis but felt that our costs would remain the same as a full time operator when we determined the tasks involved. If we hire a part time operator then we will still need to have money for his maintenance time. Since we do not have staff on hand to make distribution line repairs or standard maintenance on the equipment, we felt that a full time operator is the best use of our money. Our current system uses a remote phone system to call when there is a situation at the treatment plant. The phone system is set up to call the water operator or the operation's manager. Sometimes Donald or Michelle are called at night or early in the morning. Often times they have experienced the system calling them at 2:00 am to report a security breach, or system problem. Since the treatment facility is located 2 miles away, one or both, must go to the facility to confirm the alarm situation. Dateland does not have a police department so our personnel are required to confirm the alarm or see if there is a security breach. DPSC has a solar system that cost \$311,000 so it is imperative that when an alarm call is made that personnel go to the facility to confirm if there is a security breach.

Because of the factors involved in our situation and our remoteness, it is cost effective to have full time staff to meet our needs. We don't have the luxury of time, calling someone out of Yuma or Phoenix, we need someone who lives within our community.

The next largest factor is for pond maintenance, equipment maintenance, repair and replacement costs. Our electrical system costs around \$90,000 to install and "all" equipment is ran off of this system (Quantum). In order for our RO system to run the VFD well pump must obtain and sustain 100gpm. Our pre-treatment (Everfilt) has four storage vessels each containing a special medium. The levels of the medium must be checked, verified and maintained by our water operator. The vessels must be cleaned out based on the hours of use. These vessels clean the water before it runs through our RO membranes removing many contaminates. This system also requires the use of salt to flush out the vessels, this is done as needed based upon equipment pressures. In order for our treatment systems to run properly "all" systems must be checked daily for problems. Example: If the well pump does not maintain it's required gpm then the RO will not run. We can still process water through our pre-treatment but it will not remove Arsenic or Fluoride. These two contaminates are over the MCL levels and require DPSC to RO our water before it goes out to our customers.

DPSC has specialized equipment that require hands on maintenance and operator specialized knowledge therefore we feel justified in requesting adequate pay for our water operator. USDA requires that we maintain our equipment and in order to meet this requirement money must be available to us to fulfill our part of the agreement.

A Bill Count Summary sheet is provided on page 31. Please note that each bill over 100,000 gallons should be shown separately. The number of bills in each line will be added to produce a total of all bills at the bottom of the page.

The first step in producing the Bill Count is to collect all monthly bills rendered for metered water sales during the 12 months of the Test Year. The collection of bills must include bills to part-time customers and to customers who are no longer on the system, but who were on the system for any part of the Test Year.

Only include bills for water sold during the Test Year. For example, assume that the Test Year runs from January 1st to December 31st (calendar year) and you normally bill on January 5th. The bill sent out at that time would cover December 1st through 31st usage of the prior year and should not be included. The first billing to be used for the year would be the February 5th billing and the last billing to be used would be the billing of January 5th of the succeeding year.

Sort the bills by each quarter, by meter size, so that a separate bill count is produced for each three-month period by meter size. On each quarterly Bill Count sheet, place a tally for each bill in the appropriate gallonage range. After tallying each bill, add the tallies in each gallonage range and report the tally totals in the column provided.
