**ADJUSTMENT SCHEDULE REAC-1
RENEWABLE ENERGY STANDARD**

APPLICATION

The Renewable Energy Standard Adjustment Schedule ("REAC") shall apply to all retail Standard Offer or Direct Access service. All provisions of the customer's current applicable rate schedule will apply in addition to adjustment schedule REAC-1. This schedule shall recover the revenue requirements from the Renewable Energy Standard that are not other-wise recovered in base rates. The kWh charge and monthly surcharge limits shall be revised annually, as necessary, as approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"). Any new charges and surcharge limits will be applied in billing cycle 1 in the January revenue month, or as otherwise ordered by the Commission, and will not be prorated. Details regarding the administration of this Adjustor can be found in A.A.C. R14-2-1808. Adjustment schedules REAC-1 and DSMAC-1 may be combined on the customer's bill and shown on the "Environmental Benefits Surcharge" line.

~~As provided in Arizona Corporation Commission decision 73183, customers who receive an incentive under the Renewable Energy Standard and install their system after July 1, 2012 or interconnect to the APS system after March 1, 2013, will pay the applicable average monthly surcharge as detailed below limit. This provision shall be effective in billing cycle 1 after Commission approval in Decision number XXXXX. APS reprograms its billing system to accomplish this, or with the March 2013 billing, whichever is sooner.~~

SURCHARGE FOR CUSTOMERS WITH DISTRIBUTED GENERATION

As provided by the Commission in Decision Nos. 73183 and 74237, customers who receive an incentive under the Renewable Energy Standard and install a distributed generation facility after July 1, 2012 or those that interconnect a facility to the APS system after March 1, 2013 regardless of receiving an incentive, will pay the following applicable surcharge, which is based on the average monthly surcharge for each billing class.

DETERMINATION OF NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER BILLING CLASSES

*Per Arizona Corporation Commission Decision 73636, the Renewable Energy Standard Adjustment Charge limit for Non-residential Customers with demand of 3,000 kW or higher per month for three consecutive months will increase \$200.00 every 2 months until reaching \$2,200.00 per month on January 1, 2014.

Customers served under 47, E-58, E-59, Contract 12, E-67, and E-20 will be subject to the Extra Small/Small surcharge. Customers served under Rate Schedules E-32 Medium and E-32TOU Medium will be subject to the Medium surcharge. Customers served under Rate Schedules E-32 Large, E-32 TOU Large, E-36M (with the M option), and Schools TOU Large will be subject to the Large surcharge. Customers served under Rate Schedules E-34, E-35, and E-36 XL will be subject to the Extra Large surcharge.

Customers served under Rate Schedules E-221, and E-2218T will be subject to the applicable surcharge based on their monthly billing demand as follows: less than or equal to 100 kW – extra small/small surcharge; 101 to 400 kW – medium surcharge, 401 kW and greater – large surcharge.

Customers served under Schools TOU Medium will be subject to the applicable surcharge based on their monthly billing demand as follows: less than or equal to 100 kW – extra small/small surcharge; 101 and greater – medium surcharge.

The surcharge for Customers billed under any rate rider schedule will be determined by the parent rate schedules as described above.
