To Whom It May Concern:

I am a customer of Montezuma Rimrock Water Company, LLC. I am surprised to hear that the Arizona Corporation Commission has yet to still approve the rate increase for the arsenic treatment system. Without this rate increase, the water company is unable to move forward with their ability to try to reconnect well #4, the Tiemann Well, to the system. This means that each customer and non-customer is without enough water to protect our community. The Yarnell fire which occurred last year, damaged and destroyed many homes and cost the lives of many people. Should a fire of that magnitude occur within our community, it would render Montezuma Rimrock Water Company helpless in their ability to help contain the fire and the damage to our community. There is a drinking water system security act which does not allow you, John Dougherty or Ivo Buddeke to disrupt our water supply. I believe this law even applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission because if a fire were to occur, you, at this time, are disrupting the ability of the water company to provide a safe and reliable supply of drinking water.

Title II of H.R. 2868 (formerly H.R. 3258) replaces Section 1433 of the Safe Drinking Water Act to strengthen security at drinking water facilities to prevent an intentional act that causes a chemical release, contaminates the water supply, or otherwise disrupts the ability of a water system to provide a safe and reliable supply of drinking water.
