Commissioners:

The policy of Net Metering is causing some divisiveness in our communities that is only holding us back on our path to progress and the #2 state to produce the most solar energy in the nation. When the rest of the country looks to us as a leader in pushing forward this innovative energy solution of installing solar panels on houses and businesses, must it also see the inequality brooding underneath?

The Net Metering policy is to our shame. It essentially ensures that customers who put solar panels on their houses will enjoy nearly free energy and pass along their costs to the rest of the community, amounting to \$20,000 over the 20-year lifetime of each system installed. At the same time, they are free to go about their lives without sharing in the communal support of the energy grid that supplies energy to their homes every day, and which must be sustained and kept operating.

Who is paying for all this? The non-solar customers, many of whom are on fixed income or cannot afford to experience higher costs. We are setting up a dangerous imbalance in our communities that can only breed resentment of neighbor against neighbor, due to a poorly-constructed policy that must now be changed. I urge you to work to revise the Net Metering policy, in the name of fairness for all. Thank you
