

**PUBLIC NOTICE

AN APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER  
AUTHORIZING THE ARIZONA ELECTRIC POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.  
TO OBTAIN TWO COMMITTED REVOLVING LINES OF CREDIT**

The Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPCO") has filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for an order authorizing it to obtain two committed revolving lines of credit in the combined amount of \$100 million (Docket No. E-01773A-14-0019). The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Commission in Phoenix, Arizona, and AEPCO's offices at 1000 South Highway 80, Benson, Arizona 85602. It may also be viewed on the Commission's website at [www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function, located at the bottom of the website home page.

Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the application shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct substantial interest in this matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a Motion to Intervene with the Commission which must be served upon AEPCO and which, at a minimum, shall contain the following information:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding.
3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the application and the reasons for such a hearing.
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the Motion to Intervene has been mailed to AEPCO.

The granting of Motions to Intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all Motions to Intervene must be filed on, or before, the 15<sup>th</sup> day after publication of this Notice.
