PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Granting Interventions and
Authorizing Lay Representation)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 24, 2014, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") opened the above captioned generic docket for purposes of gathering stakeholder input.

On February 14, 2014, The Alliance for Solar Choice ("TASC") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene.

On February 18, 2014, Clean Power Arizona ("Clean Power") filed a Motion to Intervene. Clean Power is an Arizona non-profit corporation formed on October 15, 2013. Clean Power's motion states that Dillon Holmes, president of Clean Power, is authorized to represent Clean Power in this proceeding. According to the information provided in Clean Power's Motion to Intervene, Mr. Holmes meets the requirements for lay representation before the Commission in this matter pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 31(d)(28).

On February 27, 2014, Freeport-McMoran Copper & Gold, Inc. ("Freeport-McMoran") and Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") jointly filed an Application for Leave to Intervene.

There have been no objections filed to the intervention requests. Accordingly, TASC, Freeport-McMoran and AECC should be granted intervention. Clean Power should also be granted intervention and Mr. Holmes should be authorized to appear as its lay representative, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 31(d)(28).

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that The Alliance for Solar Choice, Clean Power Arizona,
2 Freeport-McMoran Copper & Gold, Inc., and Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition are
3 hereby granted intervention.


4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dillon Holmes is hereby authorized to represent Clean
5 Power Arizona in this proceeding pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 31(d)(28). In the
6 discretion of the Commission, counsel in lieu of lay representation may be required whenever the
7 Commission determines that lay representation is interfering with the orderly progress of the
8 proceeding, imposing undue burdens on the other parties, or causing harm to the parties represented.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules
10 31, 38, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
12 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona
13 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at
14 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
15 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
16 Administrative Law Judge.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
18 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
19 ruling at hearing.
