PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Grants an Extension of Time)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 10, 2014, White Hills Water Company, Inc. ("White Hills" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water utility services to an area known as Golden Horseshoe Ranchos subdivision, located in White Hills, Arizona.

On February 7, 2014, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket stating that White Hills' application had met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.").

On February 26, 2014, by Procedural Order, the hearing in this matter was set to be held on April 16, 2014, and other procedural deadlines were established.

On March 7, 2014, Staff filed a Request for an Extension of Time to File Staff Report. Staff's request states that Staff needs an extension of time, until March 24, 2014, to properly prepare its Staff Report. Staff also requests that the deadline for the Company to file objections to the Staff Report remain the same. Staff states that the Company has no objection to Staff's request for an extension of time or to maintaining the current timeframe for the Company to file objections to the Staff Report.

Accordingly, Staff's request for an extension of time should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff's request for an extension of time, until March 24, 2014, to file its Staff Report is hereby granted.



7 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
8 hearing.


