PROCEDURAL ORDER  
(Grants Intervention)

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On November 19, 2013, Circle City Water Company, L.L.C. ("Circle City") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application requesting approval to delete portions of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") and to delete the requirement for Circle City to file a rate application, pursuant to Decision No. 68246 (October 25, 2005). Circle City's application requests deletion of those portions of its CC&N encompassing a development known as Lake Pleasant 5000. Circle City's application states that the Lake Pleasant 5000 project is not viable and that service in the CC&N area will not be necessary in the foreseeable future.

On December 31, 2013, intervention was granted to Lake Pleasant 5000, L.L.C. ("LP5K").

On January 9, 2014, Rex G. Maughan and Ruth G. Maughan, Trustees of the Maughan Revocable Trust of 2007 ("MRT") filed an Application for Leave to Intervene.

No objections to MRT's request to intervene have been filed. Therefore, it is appropriate to grant MRT's request to intervene in this matter.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Rex G. Maughan and Ruth G. Maughan, Trustees of the Maughan Revocable Trust of 2007 are hereby granted intervention in the above-captioned docket.**

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court  
2 Rules 31, 38, and 42 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
4 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona  
5 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at  
6 all hearings, procedural conferences, and Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for  
7 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative  
8 Law Judge or Commission.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
10 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
11 hearing.
