PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 22, 2013, Payson Water Co., Inc. ("PWC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application in Docket No. W-03514A-13-0111 for a determination of the fair value of its utility plant and property and for increases in its water rates and charges for utility service.

On May 27, 2013, PWC filed with the Commission an application in Docket No. W-03514A-13-0142 for authority to (1) issue evidence of indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$1,238,000 on the terms and conditions set forth by the Water Infrastructure and Finance Authority, and (2) encumber its real property and utility plant as security for such indebtedness.

By Procedural Order issued August 26, 2013, Docket Nos. W-03514A-13-0111 and W-03514A-13-0142 were consolidated.

On March 20, 2014, the Commission voted at a Staff Open Meeting to conduct a local public comment session in Payson, Arizona,.

1 By Procedural Order issued March 21, 2014, the public comment session was scheduled for
2 April 11, 2014, in Payson, and PWC was ordered to provide public notice of the public comment
3 session. Although the notice correctly stated (on page 2 of the Procedural Order) that “[t]he
4 Commission will hold a public comment session on the application on April 11, 2014, commencing
5 at 6:00 p.m., at the Church of the Nazarene, 200 E. Tyler Parkway, Payson, Arizona 85541,” the line
6 directly above that information (line 18) included a typographical error indicating that the public
7 comment was in “Yuma, Arizona.”

8 On March 27, 2014, PWC filed a Notice of Correction stating that it “identified this
9 typographical error and made the correction in the notice being mailed and published.” Attached to
10 PWC’s filing was Exhibit A which shows the corrected text of the notice substituting “Payson,
11 Arizona” for “Yuma, Arizona.”

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that since Payson Water Company, Inc., has already mailed
13 and published the required notice, with a correction of the typographical error contained in the March
14 21, 2014, Procedural Order, no further action is required at this time regarding notice of the public
15 comment session scheduled for April 11, 2014, in Payson, Arizona. An affidavit of compliance with
16 the notice requirements is due to be filed by no later than April 8, 2014, as set forth in the March 21,
17 2014, Procedural Order.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, the March 21, 2014, Procedural Order
19 shall remain in full force and effect.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
21 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
22 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
24 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
25 hearing.


