Mohave Cooperative Services, Inc. ("MCS"), by and through its counsel undersigned, filed an application to cancel the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") issued to MCS by Decision No. 67673. This pleading supplements and corrects the original application as follows:

1. MCS, which has no customers and is no longer operating, is seeking to cancel all aspects of the Certificate granted pursuant to Decision No. 67673 and to terminate all service tariffs associated therewith.
2. MCS notified its limited customer base of its intent to halt providing VoIP service in March of 2012, rather than March of 2013 as stated in the original application. Copies of the notice mailed to customers, as well as the affidavit of publication from the Mohave Valley Daily News relating to the notice published in March 2012 are attached as Exhibit A and B, have been provided directly to Staff in response to data requests.

1 3. MCS revised the form of notice and it was published on March 16, 2014 (instead of on
2 or before March 10, 2014) in the Mohave Daily News (instead of the Kingman Miner).
3 The revised form of notice is attached hereto as amended Exhibit C and the affidavit of
4 publication is attached as Exhibit D.

5 4. To the extent the March 2012 notices and March 16, 2014 notice do not fully satisfy
6 A.A.C. R14-2-1107(B), MCS requests the notice requirement be waived.

7 5. MCS has submitted a performance bond in the amount of \$135,000 that is due to
8 expire April 30, 2014. MCS requests that the performance bond be released and
9 returned.

10 WHEREFORE, MCS respectfully requests the Commission enter an order:

- 11 1. Cancelling the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted pursuant to Decision
12 No. 67673, together with the service tariffs associated therewith;

14 2. Finding the notices provided March 2012 and March 2014 satisfy A.A.C. R14-2-
15 1107(B), or alternatively waive any further notice requirement;

17 3. Releasing and returning the performance bond posted by MCS; and

19 4. Granting such other and further relief as the Commission determines to be just and
20 reasonable.




