PROCEDURAL ORDER

11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

 13 In Decision No. 73912 (April 16, 2013), the Arizona Corporation Commission
 14 (“Commission”) approved a settlement agreement that provided for new rates and charges for Tucson
 15 Electric Power Company (“TEP” or Company”). The settlement agreement provided that TEP was to
 16 file by August 30, 2013, a proposed tariff for interruptible rates and that the Commission’s Utilities
 17 Division (“Staff”) would review the filing and docket a Staff Report and Proposed Order for the
 18 consideration of the Commission by December 31, 2013.¹ Decision No. 73912 also required TEP to
 19 file on or before August 30, 2013, a revised Partial Requirements Service Tariff and a Super-Peak
 20 Time-of-Use Tariff.²

21 In Decision No. 74163 (October 25, 2013), the Commission granted TEP’s request for more
 22 time to file the tariffs, and extended the deadline for TEP to file the tariffs until October 30, 2013,
 23 and for Staff to file a Staff Report and Proposed Order until March 31, 2014. TEP filed the tariffs on
 24 October 30, 2013.

2 Staff Report and Proposed Order. Staff states that it requires addition information from the Company
3 and needs additional time to prepare its Staff Report and Proposed Order.

4 The record does not indicate if there are any objections to Staff's Motion.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that any party objecting to the Staff Motion shall file a
6 Response no later than April 11, 2014.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
8 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
9 hearing.
