





Summary

Midvale Telephone Company, Inc. ("MTCI") has applied to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"), to include customer locations currently within the service area of Qwest dba CenturyLink-GC ("CenturyLink"). MTCI desires Commission authorization to provide facilities-based local exchange service and toll service in an area of Yavapai County immediately contiguous to the Long Meadows portion of MTCI's Mill Site Exchange ("extension area"). The extension area contains 8 residences, 2 of which already obtain service from MTCI. CenturyLink has no customers in the extension area and supports MTCI's application. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended approval of MTCI's application, subject to certain conditions.

The commission is not bound by the proposals made by MTCI, CenturyLink, Staff, or any intervenor. The Commission will issue a Decision regarding this case after consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. If MTCI's application is approved, MTCI will be required to provide service under the rates, charges, terms, and conditions established by the Commission.
