**SOLAR ENERGY INDUSTRIES
ASSOCIATION'S APPLICATION
FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105, the Solar Energy Industries Association (SEIA) hereby applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) for an order granting SEIA leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding.

Rule 14-3-105 provides that "persons, other than the original parties to the proceedings, who are directly and substantially affected by the proceedings, shall secure an order from the Commission or presiding officer granting leave to intervene before being allowed to participate." In support of this Application, SEIA states the following:

- 1) SEIA is a non-profit trade association representing local, national, and international solar companies from all industry sectors in the Arizona market;
- 2) The Application includes numerous proposals that will substantially and directly impact the policies, economics and mechanics of the solar business and the interests of SEIA's members and their respective customers;

3) The outcome of the Docket will directly and substantially impact SEIA and the business of its members and their respective customers in Arizona; and

4) Granting SEIA intervenor status will not delay this proceeding, unduly broaden the issues or prejudice UNS Energy Corporation, and no other party can adequately represent SEIA's interests in this matter.

The January 10, 2014 Joint Notice of Intent filed in this docket specifically identified a broad landscape of issues directly related to SEIA and its members. These issues include, delivery of increased renewable energy, integration of distributed generation into the utility grid, innovations in the nature and delivery of electrical service, and purchases of generation. For these reasons, SEIA respectfully requests intervenor status. Only through direct participation in this proceeding can SEIA's interests be protected.
