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PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

The hearing in this matter convened on March 25, 2014. On March 31, 2014, South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc. ("SCU") filed post-hearing exhibits as requested.

During the hearing the witness for SCU testified that he did not know how much Federal High Cost Loop Support ("FHCLS") SCU received in the test year. (See Hearing Transcript at 30). The information does not appear to be contained elsewhere in the record.


Late-file Exhibit A-3 contains an analysis of the effect on operating income of not raising SCU's current local exchange rates to the FCC's announced \$20.46 rate floor. That Exhibit indicates that in such case, SCU would lose \$50,698 in FHCLS, however, the exhibit indicates that the loss would affect interstate operations rather than intrastate operations.

It would be helpful in the preparation of the Recommended Opinion and Order ("ROO") in this matter if SCU would supplement the record with the amount of FHCLS received in the test year, both total amount and that portion attributable to its Arizona operations, if possible; and to confirm the accuracy of Exhibit A-3, or prepare a revised schedule. Because of the short timeframe for the preparation of the ROO, SCU is requested to provide the information as soon as possible, but no later than April 25, 2014.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that SCU shall supplement the record in this matter, by
2 filing with Docket Control, information responsive to the questions set forth as soon as possible, but
3 no later than April 25, 2014.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
5 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
6 hearing.


