**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Schedules Procedural Conference)**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On February 24, 2014, Walden Meadows Community Cooperative (“Walden Meadows” or “Complainant”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) a Formal Complaint against ACME Water, LLC (“ACME” or “Respondent”) alleging that ACME is in arrears for purchased water and that ACME’s water system has undiscovered line breaks.

On April 7, 2014, a Procedural Order was issued directing ACME to file an Answer to the Complaint no later than April 18, 2014.

On April 18, 2014, ACME filed an Answer to the Complaint.

Accordingly, a procedural conference should be held to determine the appropriate procedural schedule for this matter. Further, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) should be directed to participate in the procedural conference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a procedural conference shall commence on **May 8, 2014, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission’s offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 2, Phoenix, Arizona. 
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff is hereby directed to appear for the procedural  
2 conference.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules  
4 31, 38, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
6 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona  
7 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at  
8 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is  
9 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
10 Administrative Law Judge.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
12 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
13 hearing.
