**Notice of Application RAILROAD CROSSING UPGRADE**

UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD AND BROADWAY ROAD, TEMPE

**IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO UPGRADE AN EXISTING CROSSING OF THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AT BROADWAY ROAD IN THE CITY OF TEMPE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, USDOT NO. 741-565L (DOCKET NO. RR-03639A-14-0078).**

On March 4, 2014, Arizona Department of Transportation ("Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval for the Union Pacific Railroad Company to upgrade an existing crossing at Broadway Road in the city of Tempe, Maricopa County, Arizona, at AAR/DOT No. 741-565L. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the Commission's office, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and on the internet via the Commission's website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter commencing on May 29, 2014, at 10 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 2, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Application or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of Railroad, a neighboring property owner, a crossing user, etc.);
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before April 30, 2014. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf. If you have any questions about this application, you may contact the applicant at 602-712-7149. If you wish to file written comments on the application or want further information on intervention, you may write the Customer Services Section of the Commission at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, call 602-542-4251 or 1-800-222-7000, or appear at the hearing and make comment.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission of its public meetings.
