### 11 RUCO'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

12 I.

13 The RESIDENTIAL UTILITY CONSUMER OFFICE ("RUCO") hereby applies to the  
14 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an Order granting it leave to  
15 intervene in the above-captioned proceeding.

16 II.

17 RUCO was established by the enactment of Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 40-  
18 461, *et seq.*, for the purpose of representing residential utility consumers in matters before  
19 the Commission concerning regulated public service corporations.

20 III.

21 Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 40-464.A.2., specifically provides that the  
22 Director of RUCO may do the following:

23 Prepare and present briefs, arguments, proposed rates or  
24 orders and intervene or appear on behalf of residential utility

1 consumers before hearing officers and the Corporation  
2 Commission as a party in interest and also participate as a  
3 party in interest pursuant to Section 40-254 in proceedings  
relating to rate making or rate design and involving public  
service corporations.

4 IV.

5 The residential utility consumers will be directly and substantially affected by a  
6 Decision or Order of the Commission in this matter, therefore, it is necessary and proper  
7 that RUCO intervene in the proceeding.

8 V.


9 In order to fulfill its statutory obligation to protect the residential utility consumers of  
10 this State, RUCO must thoroughly examine the issues raised. Additionally, RUCO may  
11 present testimony and exhibits of its own in any hearings conducted by the Commission in
