PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Grants Application to Withdraw)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 16, 2011, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Weldon Beall, and Weldon LLC, an Arizona limited liability company ("Weldon"), (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On April 27, 2011, a request for hearing and an Answer were filed by on behalf of the Respondents.

On May 2, 2011, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on May 26, 2011.

On May 26, 2011, the Division and Respondent appeared with counsel. Counsel for the Division indicated that the parties were attempting to reach a settlement in the proceeding and would submit a proposed form of Consent Order for approval by the Commission. In the interim, the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled in the event that the parties could not reach a resolution of the issues raised by the Notice.

1 On May 31, 2011, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled, and subsequently Decision
2 No. 74149 (October 25, 2013) was issued by the Commission finding Respondents in violation of
3 the Act. This Decision was not appealed by the Respondents, and became final.

4 On March 28, 2014, counsel for the Respondents filed an Application to Withdraw as Counsel
5 ("Application") for all named Respondents stating that he is permanently retiring as an attorney at
6 law and closing his office. He further stated that he had advised Respondents of these circumstances.

7 On May 14, 2014, by Procedural Order, the Division was directed to file a response to the
8 Application.

9 On May 16, 2014, the Division filed its response stating that it has no objections to the
10 Application.

11 Accordingly, counsel's Application should be granted.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application by counsel for the Respondents is hereby
13 granted.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
15 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


