Dear Commissioner Bitter Smith,

I live in Mesa del Caballo which is serviced by the Payson Water Company. We are now on Stage 4. The customers in Mesa del Caballo starting paying, on our last water bill a \$6.76 WIIFA Surcharge for the pipeline that could bring us water purchased from the Town of Payson. However that pipeline is empty. Payson Water Company can still haul water and charge its customers for the water PLUS the hauling charge since no provision was made at the time the pipeline was authorized by the Commission. Last summer we used 2650 gallons for the July to August period and the water cost us \$5.11 but with the augmentation charge the water cost us an additional \$35.03 an increase of nearly 7 times and in June to July 2013 we used 2790 gallons of water that cost us \$5.38 since plus an addition \$102.39 or nearly 20 times the cost and I can go on for May to June, April to May etc.

Can't you do something to prevent us from having to pay these huge water augmentation charges?
Why do the Mesa del Caballo customers have to wait to get relief when a simple solution is available but not acted on? It is my understanding that the Rate Case cannot be on the May 13 Agenda but there is a backup date of May 22, please get this on the Agenda.

I look forward to your response.
