BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. In Commission Decision No. 63605 (April 24, 2001), the Commission granted Coin Phone Management Company ("CPMC" or "Applicant") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide customer owned pay telephone ("COPT") services in Arizona.
2. On February 19, 2014, CPMC filed an application with the Commission requesting approval to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona.
3. On March 10, 2014, CPMC filed an amended application to waive the right to a hearing and to receive notice of a hearing in order to cancel the CC&N.
4. On April 10, 2014, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Memorandum in response to CPMC's application to cancel its CC&N. The application indicated CPMC no longer provides, or never did provide, COPT services in the State of Arizona. Staff states Ms. Sharon Ferguson indicated that she was authorized to file the application on behalf of the Applicant.

1 According to Staff, the Commission’s Consumer Services Section reported that no complaints,
2 inquires, or opinions have been filed against CPMC. Further, the Commission’s Compliance Section
3 reports that no compliance items or delinquencies have been reported for the Applicant.

4 5. While Staff indicated the Commission’s Corporations Division reported the Applicant
5 was not in good standing for failure to file an annual report for 2013 or 2014, Staff recommends
6 approval of CPMC’s application to cancel its CC&N and recommends that the Applicant no longer
7 be subject to the filing requirements set forth in Decision No. 63605.

8 6. Staff’s recommendation to approve CPMC’s application for cancellation of its CC&N
9 is reasonable and should be adopted.

10 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

11 1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
12 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

13 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over CPMC and the subject matter of the
14 application.

15 3. The cancellation of CPMC’s CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona is in the
16 public interest.

17 4. CPMC waives its right to notice and a hearing in this matter.

18 5. Staff’s recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.




ORDER
