

16 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
17 Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

18 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 19 1. On July 5, 2012, Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPCO") filed with the
20 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate decrease.
- 21 2. On October 25, 2013, the Commission issued Decision No. 74173.
- 22 3. Decision No. 74143 ordered the record in this case to be held open until April 30,
23 2014, for the limited purpose of allowing AEPCO to file, if it so chose, after collaboration with the
24 Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff"), for Commission approval, a proposed Environmental
25 Compliance Adjustment Rider ("ECAR") and plan of administration that fully addresses the technical
26 points raised by Staff in the rate proceeding. Due to the possibility of significant rate increases
27 through an ECAR surcharge that would be passed on to the customers of AEPCO's Class A member
28 distribution cooperatives in the event an ECAR is approved, Decision No. 74173 also ordered

1 AEPCO to provide notice of its filing to the customers of its member distribution cooperatives in a
2 form acceptable to Staff. Decision No. 74143 ordered AEPCO to file proof of notice within 30 days
3 of the filing of an ECAR application.

4 4. On April 30, 2014, AEPCO filed in this docket an Application for Approval of the
5 ECAR Plan of Administration and Tariff.

6 5. On May 23, 2014, AEPCO filed a Motion to Extend Proof of Notice Deadline Re
7 ECAR Application. Therein, AEPCO stated that it will take longer than the May 30, 2014 deadline
8 for AEPCO to complete the requisite customer notice of the ECAR application. AEPCO requests
9 that the deadline be extended to July 28, 2014. AEPCO states that it communicated its request to
10 Staff and the other parties to this case, and there were no objections.

11 6. Under the circumstances, it is reasonable to extend the deadline for completion of the
12 customer notice required by Decision No. 74173 to July 28, 2014.

13 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

14 1. AEPCO is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
15 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. Title 40.

16 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over AEPCO and the subject matter of this
17 proceeding.

18 3. It is reasonable and in the public interest to grant AEPCO's request for a time
19 extension to comply with the ECAR application notice requirements of Decision No. 74173.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the compliance deadline set by Decision No. 74173 for Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. to complete customer notice of its Application for Approval of an Environmental Compliance Adjustment Rider Plan of Administration and Tariff, and to file proof of such notice, is hereby extended to July 28, 2014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
