

Access Line Service (Continued)

9. Low-income customers who qualify under the Senior Telephone Discount Program (STDP) (otherwise known as Arizona Low Income Telephone Assistance Plan (ALITAP)) will receive the Federal Lifeline support amount. STDP/ALITAP customers are also eligible to receive additional state Lifeline support in an amount equal to a 17% discount of local service charges. (C)
