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

**REQUEST TO DISCONTINUE AND
CANCEL SERVICE**

CTI Long Distance, Inc., ("CTI") files this Application to Discontinue Intrastate Long Distance Service pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-1107.

Due to changing market conditions, including the introduction of free domestic long distance calling on wireless communications networks and over the Internet, CTI has determined that it is no longer economically feasible for CTI to continue providing resold, intrastate interexchange long distance service in the State of Arizona.

CTI currently provides long distance service to 37 customers in the State of Arizona. CTI seeks to have its customers choose another long distance service provider prior to its planned discontinuance of service effective on **December 3, 2014**.

Through this application, CTI certifies that all affected customers have been notified of the proposed discontinuance and all have access to another long distance service provider. There are countless long distance service providers available to Arizona customers, and it is not feasible to list all of the providers. Available alternate providers include CenturyLink, Verizon Wireless, T-Mobile, Sprint, AT&T, and Skype.

CTI will also publish notice in newspapers of general circulation in the counties where affected customers currently reside and will file the appropriate Affidavit of Publication upon completion.

CTI also certifies that no customer deposits are held by CTI.

Based on the foregoing, CTI respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order that does the following:

- A. Approves CTI's Application pursuant to ACC R14-2-1107 without a hearing; and
- B. Cancels CTI's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.
