On April 1, 2014, Warren Woodward ("Complainant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Formal Complaint against Arizona Public Service Company ("Respondent"). On April 24, 2014, Respondent filed a Motion to Dismiss and Alternatively APS's Answer to Formal Complaint ("Motion to Dismiss and Answer").

On May 6, 2014, Complainant filed a letter in reply to the Motion to Dismiss and Answer.

On May 19, 2014, Complainant filed a letter with an attachment.

A procedural conference should be held to discuss procedural matters.


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1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a procedural conference in this matter shall be held on
