MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF DEADLINE FOR EXCHANGING WITNESS AND EXHIBIT LISTS AND FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

(Assigned to Hon. Marc E. Stern)

The Securities Division, with the agreement of the remaining Respondents in this matter, William and Linda Nordstrom, move to continue the deadline by which the parties are to exchange witness and exhibit lists, currently set for August 1, 2014, and the hearing set in this matter, currently scheduled for September 15 – 19, 2014. The parties request that both deadlines be continued approximately eight weeks past their respective, currently-scheduled dates, to dates that the court deems appropriate.

On a showing of good cause, a matter may be continued for any proper purpose.¹ There are three reasons to continue the hearing.

First, one of the Division's key witnesses will be unavailable during the week of the hearing. This witness's testimony is necessary to help establish the restitution amounts and also helps establish portions of the Division's fraud claims.

1 Second, Respondent William Nordstrom's cancer treatments, discussed at the April 21,
2 2014 status conference and at pages 1 – 2 of the April 24, 2014 Procedural Order in this matter,
3 have continued later than anticipated. A continuance will allow Respondent more time to
4 recover and prepare for the hearing.

5 Finally, the parties continue to negotiate the terms of a settlement. Continuing the
6 hearing would allow the parties additional time to negotiate a settlement and possibly forego the
7 hearing.

8 For these three reasons, the exhibit-exchange and hearing dates should be continued by at
9 least eight weeks.

10 Respondent Nordstroms' counsel, Bradley Weech, has reviewed this motion and agrees to
11 the requests in this motion.
