Respondents MOVE for an Order extending the date for filing Respondents' Post-Hearing Brief from July 21, 2014 to August 12, 2014 due to the medical issues Respondents' counsel has experienced, as described below.

Respondents' undersigned counsel had cataract surgery on July 1, 2014, replacing the lens in his right eye. An additional surgery is scheduled for August 4, 2014 to replace the lens in his left eye. Respondents' counsel is severely myopic. His present visual condition, one eye providing nearly perfect distant vision and

the other providing extremely poor vision is extremely confusing, making it difficult to read, write or type for more than short periods. The glasses he used prior to surgery now are useless. Reading glasses are required to permit reading with his surgically corrected eye. While the reading glasses permit Respondents' counsel to read and type, he must keep his left eye closed or experience considerable strain and confusion in doing so. While counsel is able to cope with ordinary correspondence during the month-long wait for his second surgery, responding to a 24 page brief has proven to be quite difficult, suggesting that counsel be afforded the courtesy of additional time, so that he has two functioning eyes when he completes that job.

Respondents' counsel's cataract surgery had not been recommended by his ophthalmologist or scheduled at the time the briefing schedule was agreed. Although the Security Division's Post-Hearing brief was filed on June 23, 2014, Respondent's counsel did not receive it in the mail until June 26, the Thursday before his first cataract surgery occurred. The difficulty counsel is experiencing is not usual and was not anticipated, although it apparently is not unusual with persons of his age and degree of myopia.

Respondent attempted to contact Ryan Millecam, the Security Division's attorney, but without success.
