Dear Mr. Chairman and Commissioners,

On June 20, 2014, the Arizona Corporation Commission issued Decision No. 74562 granting White Hills Water Co. Inc. a CC&N in Mohave County. The CC&N area granted by the Commission was less than what we requested and did not include some areas originally in the Company's CC&N prior to that CC&N being revoked in Decision No. 65649 for failing to file our 2001 Utilities Division Annual Report. In Decision No. 74562, Staff recommended, and the Commission approved, a limited CC&N area to only cover the areas where White Hills Water was serving existing customers.

On July 11, 2014, White Hills Water received a letter from Mr. John Stevens requesting water service in Golden Horse Shoe Ranchos Subdivision 6, lot 74. (See attached letter) White Hills Water formerly served customers in this area and already has infrastructure in place to provide the requested service. However, at the time the Commission issued Decision No. 74562 we had no customers or requests to serve customers in the area so Staff recommended against our request to include this area in our new CC&N.

We have notified Staff of Mr. Stevens' request for service and Staff has informed us that it would support the extension of our CC&N area to allow us to provide water service to his property if the Commission voted to reopen Decision No. 74562. Staff has indicated that the legal description for this new area is as follows:

The West Half of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 21 (Golden Horseshoe Ranchos, Township 27 North, Range 19 West.

We continue to believe that the Commission should grant White Hills Water all of the area that it formerly held under its revoked CC&N. However, for the sake of time, we respectfully request the Commission to reopen Decision No. 74562 pursuant to ARS § 40-252 to expand our CC&N to include at least the area necessary for White Hills Water to provide service to Mr. Stevens.
